This past month has been a month of JOY as we've been teaching at bible school & leading training events in Mae Sot, running around with a team from Vancouver, and celebrating milestones with some of the church plants down here.

We're gearing up for the end of discipleship school at the end of September, a new semester for our Apprentice church planters beginning in October, Myanmar family camp coming up soon, and much more! Please pray with us as we serve, as we surrender, as we sacrifice, and as we see the Spirit move.

Please pray with us as we seek to empower church planters to call out the giftings they see in their disciples, giving opportunities for training and equipping, and walking with brand new leaders as they make mistakes, and learn, and grow into the place that God has prepared for them in His kingdom work! It means casting vision and walking together towards the calling of God in all our lives.

Please pray for little Caleb - he got his pinky finger crushed in our backdoor and he's been in and out of the hospital - and has dealt with stitches, surgeries, infections, hospital stays, IV's, and more.
