We have seen the goodness of God so often this summer!! In July our son Karl, his wife Patricia and our granddaughter Megan came for a 3 week visit! So blessed - our hearts are full of the goodness of God.

Elvira's legs and both arms are doing well -- a much faster return of range of motion in the left arm than the right - but both are doing well. Still some pain but it is only 2 months since the last surgery and Elvira has been feeling so much better that she may tend to overdo!! Continue to pray for complete healing.

It has been an up and down battle with Albert's health. However they have finally found the cause of his toe infection --- 3 bone chips in the joint -- he must have hit it hard or perhaps driven over it with his chair and because he has little feeling in his foot did not realize it! It is almost healed over now! He does have other issues that they have not gotten to the bottom of yet but believing for healing and that he will have more good days than bad. God is faithful! Laurentiu is also struggling with some health issues we have not gotten to the bottom of -- pray for wisdom for the doctors!

We had a very blessing children's camp - God worked in the hearts of many of the children - most of which come from unsaved homes. Pray for the children - that the seed would grow and that they would be a light for Jesus in their homes and communities

We have had the privilege of hosting several churches/families at the camp site for day outings-- thankful that God has blessed us with a wonderful area where people can come and fellowship and relax in God's beautiful creation.
